Background

The Post-2015 Development Agenda and Financing for Development (FfD) processes have both set out ambitious objectives, and aim to be truly transformative. To meet this ambition, implementation and follow-up of these agendas must be rooted in the principles of transparency, accountability and participation (TAP). As cross-cutting elements, the TAP Principles underpin effective and accountable governance, which is critical to successful implementation of this new agenda. Additionally, transparent and accountable institutions and citizen participation in governance serve as prerequisites for sustainable development progress at all levels.

This side event, hosted by the Transparency, Accountability and Participation (TAP) Network and the UN Non-Governmental Liaison Service (UN-NGLS) will provide an opportunity for a wide range of experts to take a deeper examination of the outcome of the FfD3 Conference through a TAP lens, and towards ensuring that the global community effectively implements the commitments made in Addis Ababa, as well as the Post-2015 agenda and its Sustainable Development Goals.
