

Through the ntroduction of BE-PRO-MAP FITCAM aims at changing the way communities respond to corrupt practices using structured SMS



## Least and most corrupt divisions in the SWR where 10 is the most corrupt and 1 means the least corrupt



User's Perception of the Most Corrupt Department or Profession in the South **West Region** beginning with the **Divisions** 












