1. Review of notes and decisions from last Steering Committee call

3. Review of Partnership Applications

4. Update on TAP Steering Committee nomination process and review of nomination/election categories/next steps (20 minutes)

The deadline to nominate has been extended to Friday, 24 November. The Steering Committee discussed that several TAP Partners have already nominated and that organizations should continue to nominate in the coming week. The Committee discussed how to categorize organizations on the ballot, with consideration for where the organization is working. The ballot will primarily reflect national and global categories with flexibility in categorizing organizations working locally within a national context or regional organizations comprised of CSOs working nationally.

ACTION: Secretariat will review and categorize the nominations for the ballot by national and global contexts. The ballot layout will be sent to the Steering Committee via email for approval on Monday November 27th before sending it to the membership on Monday, November 27th or early Tuesday, November 28th.

5. Partnership Updates (10 minutes)

On fundraising and grant renewals, there are no present updates. The Secretariat is currently exploring renewals of grants from previous donors, while also developing a more robust fundraising strategy.

ACTION: If funding opportunities come across desks of Steering Committee members, but are aligned with the work of a global CS network, keep TAP in mind and do pass along if they arise.
