

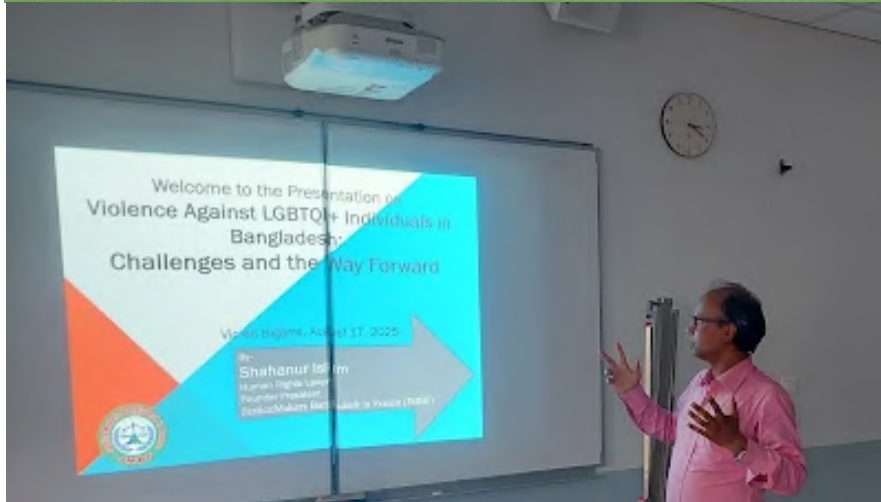

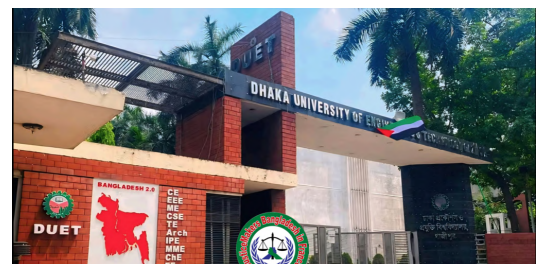

## JMBF Releases Its Annual Report 2025: State of Extrajudicial Killings and Custodial Deaths under the Interim Government in Bangladesh

(August 2024 to July 2025)



On August 25, 2025, JusticeMakers Bangladesh in France (JMBF) released its Annual Report 2025: State of Extrajudicial Killings and Custodial Deaths Under the Interim Government in Bangladesh (August 2024 – July 2025), presenting a grim account of widespread human rights violations under the Yunus-led interim administration.

The report, researched by Mosa Jannatul Ferdous and edited by Advocate Shahanur Islam, documents 60 incidents resulting in 70 victims of extrajudicial killings and custodial deaths carried out by law enforcement agencies, prison authorities, and other security forces across Bangladesh. 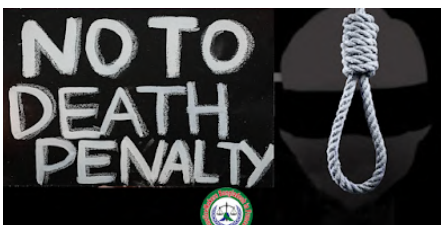
